CIRM, the voter-established institute created by Prop 71, awarded \$12.1 million in grants to cover the first year of three-year training fellowships. UCSF received 16 grants totaling just over \$1.1 million. The number of applications received was sizeable, as reported by the [San Francisco Business Times](#) [1].
