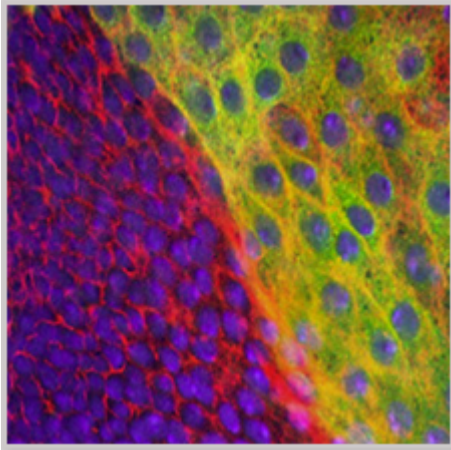


NIH Bestows DERC Distinction for Diabetes Center
