

California Supreme Court Ruling for Schoolchildren with Diabetes

After years of legal and legislative challenges, the [American Diabetes Association](#) [1] and [DREDF](#) [2] won their battle to support California students with diabetes. The California Supreme Court ruled that children may receive insulin from trained volunteers without having to wait for a school nurse.
